



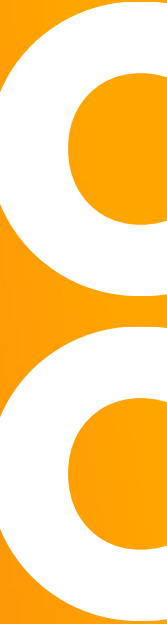

- **How?** (Ways of operating):

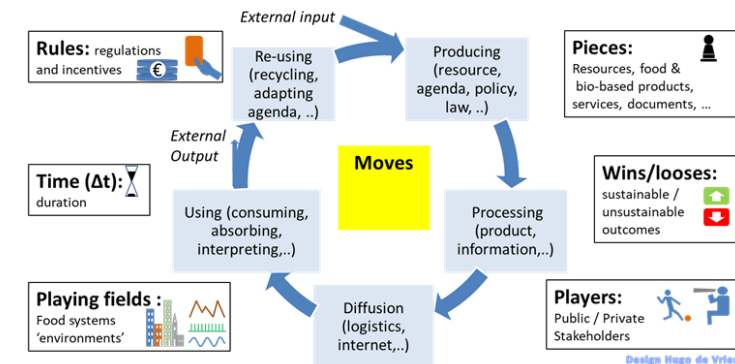
- Joint research funding activities using a *FS approach*,
